3. Elections Committee Update

a. General Election Framework

- i. JL introduced herself to the Exec and raised the General Election Framework as developed by the federal Elections Committee.
- ii. JL gave guidance for how Regional Chairs should be approaching action days and campaigning in regards to the General Election.
- iii. The framework also has other information for internal use, including the roles that various people and bodies within YL will be fulfilling.
- iv. JL also shared the YL Events Planner, which is a shared doc to input all of YL's events into, to prevent clashes and improve communication.

- i. It was highlighted that LDHQ will be releasing a map to advise activists on where to go campaigning. This can be used to guide where we send people.
- ii. **Action point:** Regional Chairs to find out which seats should be prioritised for campaigning in each region.
- iii. Members discussed the issues around General Election and Local Election planning in regards to targeting within each region and area.

- iv. In some areas it may be appropriate to campaign in held seats and advanced seats.
- v. Campaigning in moving forward seats should be done earlier in the year to allow for advanced seat prioritisation later.

 - iii. The potential value-for-money issues with having a project-focused approach to campaigning as a state-level organisation were noted.
 - iv. Project ideas raised included developing literature for campaigning in student areas, and for an experimental paid-for digital advertising campaign targeted at youth and student voters.
 - v. **Action point:** Draft a funded project proposal for submission to the English Finance and Administration Committee (EFAC).
